

# Your Pets' Go Bag



## The Brief

What do you need to have for your pet in case of emergency? Pets need go bags just like people do!

### Medical records

Make sure you have a copy of your pet's vaccination records, microchip number, and any important medical information. Also keep a recent picture so you are able to prove ownership should you become separated.



### Blankets and toys

Pack something comforting as a bed for your pet, and include a couple of toys that smell like home that they enjoy. These can be rotated through when you refresh the food.

## STEP 01

### Safe Restraint

Make sure you have readily available means to safely restrain your pets—from collars and leashes to pillow cases to carriers. Have extra identification tags to attach to collars and carriers.

### Food and water supplies

Put a couple of days of your pet's food in a waterproof container—refresh any dry food every month. Pack a gallon of water for your pet as well. Get some collapsible camping bowls for them to use. Also make sure you pack several days supplies of any medications your pet needs.
